- 1. Collection of Vegetables, on a seed tray (minimum 3 kinds)
- 2. One sort of Vegetable (any quantity)
- 3. A flowering pot plant
- 4. A foliage pot plant
- 5. A container of trees and/or shrubs showing autumn foliage and/or berries or fruit
- 6. Last rose of Summer (1 specimen bloom or 1 stem)
- 7. An Autumn/Christmas arrangement of materials from your own garden
- 8. Bread rolls (3 on a plate)
- 9. Pumpkin pie
- 10. Shortbread (5 fingers or one round)
- 11. A jar of preserve(s)
- 12. A jar of pickles / chutney
- 13. Photograph mounted or un mounted theme "Weather"
- 14. A homemade Christmas tree decoration

Rules

One entry per class per member. Vases are not provided. All flowers and vegetables must have been grown in the exhibitor's own ground. Pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least 3 months.

Judging

Judging will be for presentation and quality.

Points will be awarded for the first, second and third in each class.

There will be prizes for the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} aggregate points over classes 1-12 inclusive and prizes for Class 13 & 14.

Class 13 & 14 to be by popular vote.


